Route

The parade will begin at the Town of Sharon Maintenance Garage on Beechwood Road. It will proceed up Beechwood Road to Park Avenue, left on Park Avenue to Main Street, then right on Main Street to Route 20, right on Route 20 to the Sharon Springs Central School Parking lot.

Line Up, Registration, and Staging

ALL other entries are welcome on a first come, first served basis.
Line up, registration, and staging starts at 5:00 PM of Friday, December 7th

All Village laws and parade rules will be enforced: violators will be cited and removed from the route.

- Foul or uncooperative behavior by participants, parents, or representatives at any time during the event will result in removal. Representatives of the organizing groups are authorized to remove anyone displaying disruptive behaviors.
- *Candy, gifts, or objects may ONLY be given hand-to-hand; it is illegal and dangerous to throw items.*

All entries must pass a safety inspection at check-in:

- Participants cannot sit on the edges of the float or dangle their legs off the float.
- Unsafe entries and violators of traffic laws, rules, and regulations will be removed from the lineup.

Remember, during the parade:

- Keep a slow pace (1-3MPH). The crowd wants to get a good look at you!
- Try to maintain a close and safe distance with the entry in front of you, and approximately 50' between walking and motorized entries to minimize exhaust fumes.
