Parade Regulations

Regulations are being established to help make the parade move as efficient as possible and to make the parade route a more safe environment for the citizens and visitors watching. Violation of any regulations will result in being asked to leave the parade. Be sure to check the box on the application form acknowledging that you have read the regulations.

1. **EACH individual parade participant** must sign a **Liability Waiver**. In the case of a minor, a parent or guardian must sign. The Liability Waiver should be returned with the parade Entry Forms. If it is not known exactly who will participate in the entry, complete the waiver as best you can, and mail it with your entry forms. Additional participants, or their parents or guardians, may add their signatures to the **Liability Waiver** at **Check-In** on parade day. **NO PERSON MAY PARTICIPATE IN THE PARADE WITHOUT A SIGNATURE ON FILE.**
2. Each group will be responsible for removing their own trash. There will be trash cans out in each area of the lineup of the parade so you can dispose of your trash.
3. Please listen and abide by any instruction given to you by the Parade Managers anywhere on the parade route. Their job is to help move the parade through as quickly as possible. Be prepared to stop and move at any given moment.
4. No personal vehicles will be allowed in the line-up area. Participants can be dropped off from a personal vehicle. However, the vehicle must be removed from the line-up area, if it's not participating in the parade.
5. State law prohibits throwing of anything from your float. Items may be handed out along the parade route, at curbside, if prior approval is obtained from the Parade Committee.
6. We welcome our elected officials in the parade. However, we ask that persons running for an office do not enter the parade or line up area to campaign.
7. Children under age 10 must ride — not walk or march — in the parade and must be accompanied by a responsible adult. It is simply too hot and the parade route is too long for young children to walk. Riding in a vehicle is preferred; "riding" can also mean a bicycle, scooter or similar conveyance, but in such instances, a vehicle must follow/accompany the entry for emergency purposes. It is strongly advised that all participants bring water, especially for children and seniors.
8. Under age 18, **HELMETS ARE REQUIRED** for all riders of bicycles, skateboards, inline skates, scooters (motorized or not), motorcycles, etc.; age 18 and older, helmets are strongly encouraged.
9. Horses - Stallions are not permitted to participate in the parade. Mares and geldings only.
10. Entries may not double back along the parade route while the parade is in progress.
11. Entries that are deemed political in nature (except those of a political office holder, candidate or recognized political party), or which are deemed inappropriate by the SCV Fourth of July Parade Committee, are subject to disqualification and/or ejection from the parade.
12. Once you enter the line of march, there is **ABSOLUTELY NO STOPPING** for any reason, unless instructed by a Parade Managers.
13. Consumption or possession of alcoholic beverages or other controlled substances is forbidden.
14. Float height should be no higher than 15 feet to clear the streetlights.
15. Do not move any barricades.
16. Fireworks, Silly String, "Poppers", streamers, water guns, and projectiles of any kind are prohibited.
17. Please be courteous and do not block any driveways to the Police and Fire Departments.
18. Return back to your staging area to breakdown parade entry.
19. **You** will be responsible for the safety of all personnel riding on, in, and along, walking and driving with your group.
20. A representative of each parade entry must agree to and sign liability waiver referenced on bottom of the Entry Form.
21. All participants are invited to Sharon Central School following the parade where there will be food trucks available.
